




Inauguration

FP 2019 was inaugurated on 22 July 2019 by welcoming 209 new B.Tech. students for 2019-2023 batch. Addressing the students, Prof Amit Prashant, Officiating Director, IITGN, recalled the thought process and experience behind designing and executing pioneering student-centric programmes such as the Foundation Program and why it adds tremendous value for the students. He congratulated the new batch of students and their parents. This year, the alumni Akash Keshav Singh was one of the key speakers who shared his experiences of studying in IITGN. This was followed by talks by Tarun Kumar (2019 batch), Arpita Kabra (B. Tech Sophomore), Dean academics, Dr. Pratik Mutha and Dean of Student Affairs, Dr. Harish PM addressed the incoming students with their inspirational words.

This year, the batch has students from 20 states of the country, with the highest number of students coming from Rajasthan. The new batch has an increased gender ratio, with 17% female students joining the Institute in various disciplines.

Improv Workshop


Bollywood Dance








Social Media

Innovations

- Self Employed Womens' Association (SEWA), a prominent NGO run entirely by women hailing mostly from rural areas, offered a session on their activities related to sustainable livelihoods and women's empowerment projects. The session was received well by students. Resource persons shared their experiences of empowerment through various skill development, livelihood generation, social and economic security, and how their lives have changed after joining SEWA. The speakers encouraged the students to develop low-cost technologies which are designed in a way to address the societal issues.
- Students took a tour of Sabarmati Ashram and its museum in Ahmedabad. The Director of the Sabarmati Ashram welcomed and gave a brief talk on the history of Ashram and India's freedom movement. The aim of this visit was to learn about the father of the nation M K Gandhi and to revisit glimpses of the Indian National Movement.
- The students learnt about the wonders of nature in a snake awareness program organized by Sundarvan: Nature Discovery Centre (Ahmedabad). This was an educational talk to dispel several myths and misunderstandings about snakes and students learnt about their ecology and conservation. Live snakes were displayed and information about them were provided, which was an exciting experience for the students.
- Students gained creative communication skills, teamwork, and learned how to break inhibitions by participating in two new events introduced as part of FP 2019 Improv Workshop and "Keep Talking and No One Explodes". In Improvisational theatre, performers enact an unscripted skit based on a various topics requiring tremendous creativity and cooperation amongst the participants. In the Improv Workshop students were introduced to the basics of this art form. Students shared their real-life experiences and learned to appreciate and celebrate various skills they have, including their imperfections via this workshop. "Keep Talking and No One Explodes" was a team building game where the participants worked collectively to defuse a mock bomb that only one member of the team had visual access to. Since the bomb diffusion manual was with the other participants, playing this game required logic, presence of mind and most importantly communication and team spirit.
- We intoduced a new workshop on confict resolution run by Mr. Manish Khanolkar and Ms. Roshni Pater who are Human Resource consultants. In this workshop, students learnt about techniques for amicable conflict resolution and negotiation by participating in an interactive setting. This session was conducted with an aim to develop communication skills and teamwork among the students.
- A session on Voice Personality conducted by Mr. Shantanu, a Radio Jockey, evoked a strong interest among the students. They were introduced to the art of experimenting with their voice to augment their personality. Students learnt how they can focus on their voice, which is an integral part of their personality and how they can use it effectively on various public platforms. The session also included lessons on the techniques of handling microphones of various types, creating impact with voice modulation, etc. They even got a chance to try out the role of an RJ (Radio Jockey) in a program that was aired live.
- A new mobile App for FP2019 was developed. Students used the app to get updates about
 the sessions and the latest program schedule. Through this App, students connected with
 social media platforms such as Facebook, Twitter and the FP website. Students also used
 the App to fill up feedback forms and to connect with FP coordinators, TAs and student
 coordinators.





Recommendations

- 1. Few bottles of sanitizers are required during AMC clearing events. Face masks should be also be provided during this event. These items should be procured well in advance.
- 2. We tried scheduling events and sending invites using Google calendar. However, it didn't work well due to the dynamic nature of classroom bookings, scheduling of new events, delay in starting events due to sudden management issues, etc. The app was sufficient to inform students about the schedules on dynamic basis.
- 3. TAs should be provided with an advisory on how to manage assigned events. Such as reaching venue in advance, attendance in each event, arranging bottles, podium and stationery requirements, etc.
- 4. Having an additional staff, such as Mr. Pravinkumar, helped immensely in properly managing the official paperwork. We recommend this practice for future events.
- 5. This year, we continuously reminded students that attendance was mandatory. Thus, we did not witness any case of serious absenteeism.
- 6. TAs should be asked to document and summarize each event for better record keeping and final report generation.









Live video summary:
